June weather in Santa Barbara is generally mild, with an average high of 71 degrees, an average low of 56 degrees, and a chance of fog. Layers are recommended, especially for the cool evenings.

### Getting to Santa Barbara:

Transportation is one of the things that make Santa Barbara a congenial destination.

**By car,** you can enjoy one of the world's most spectacularly scenic drives, along Pacific Coast Highway.

**By air,** you can fly directly into enchanting little Spanish-style Santa Barbara Municipal Airport (SBA), which is just 15 minutes by car from the resort. Most flights connect from San Francisco, Los Angeles, Phoenix or Denver. Taxis are available, as are Budget, Enterprise, National and Hertz car rental desks.

Bob Hope Airport (BUR) in Burbank is about 1.5 hours from the hotel. Alamo, Avis, Hertz and National rental desks are available.

Los Angeles International Airport (LAX) is approximately 2 hours from the hotel, and has most major car rental companies on site.

**By train,** Amtrak brings you right to downtown Santa Barbara.

**Around town:** Once in Santa Barbara, getting around is easy - via electric shuttle, pedicab, renowned traveler-friendly public transit, or, of course, on foot.
