Kayakers get an up close look at the kelp forest canopy along Cannery Row, which teems with wildlife such as sea otters, harbor seals, diving pelicans. Enjoy up to 3 hours of kayaking at your leisure, including single or tandem kayaks, paddling suits to wear over your clothing, dry bags, and basic instruction. (Transportation to starting point at Cannery Row not included, but you may use the hotel-provided shuttle.)

Monterey Weather:

The Monterey coast is consistently mild. In June the average high is 67° and the average low is 50°, with the potential for fog in the mornings. Dressing in layers is advised, since the climate can vary greatly depending on time of day and proximity to the coast.

Airport Information

Fly directly into Monterey Peninsula Airport (MRY), located just 10 minutes from the hotel. Airlines servicing MRY include Alaska, American Eagle, United, Allegiant and US Airways, offering 40 flights daily. Other travel options include flying into San Jose International Airport (65 miles away) or San Francisco International Airport (110 miles away).

Ground Transportation

Complimentary shuttle service is provided between the Hyatt and the Monterey Peninsula Airport daily. We recommend calling the hotel when you land so they know to look for you.

Taxis and rental cars are readily available for passengers arriving at Monterey Regional Airport.

Guests flying into San Jose or San Francisco may wish to use the Monterey-Salinas Airbus. One-way fares from San Jose are \$40, and one-way fares from San Francisco Airport are \$50.
