- One page maximum for each essay, size 12 font, single spaced.
- No handwritten essays will be accepted.

- Write a letter to the mayor of your city outlining your concerns about a problem in your city.
- What can an individual do to protect the environment? Be specific.
- Describe an obstacle that you have overcome. Be specific.

Letters of Recommendation

Submit two letters of recommendations. One must be from a teacher (preferably math or science). The other can be from any of the following:

- Teachers
 - School counselors
 - Coaches and extracurricular activity leaders
 - Outside community members (friend of your family, church leader, business owner, past employer, etc.)
- ⇒ **Note: Letters of recommendation cannot be provided from family members.**

Letters of recommendation should include:

- A paragraph or sentence explaining how they know you and the nature of your relationship.
- An honest evaluation of your skills and accomplishments, with specific examples.
- A statement or summary that explains why they would recommend you.
- A description of an area where you need to improve.
- A contact phone number and email address to reach them.

Transcript

Include a copy of your high school transcript in the application package.

Physical Demands
